TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

E. P. Taylor

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, *I*, the said *E. P. Taylor*in and by *my* certain *1940* promissory note..... in writing, of even date with these presents, in the full and just sum of *J. J. McSavain*

Dollars, to be paid *Five hundred Dollars (\$500.00) September 1, 1936 with interest then due, and the balance of Fifteen Hundred Dollars (\$1500.00) being the remainder of the principal after deducting said five hundred dollars (\$500.00) shall be paid in ten years from date, with the right to anticipate and pay all or any part of said principal at any time, with interest thereon from *date* at the rate of *8% per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually on September 1st of each year**

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note..... to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note..... after maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interest to place, and the holder should place, the said note..... or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses, including 10..... per cent. of the indebtedness as attorney's fees, and to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN THAT..... the said *E. P. Taylor*in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *J. J. McSavain*according to the terms of the said note....., and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars *me*, the said *E. P. Taylor*in hand well and truly paid by the said *J. J. McSavain*at and before the signing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said *J. J. McSavain*,

Also those two (2) tracts or parcels of land in said County and State near the City of Greenville, and known and designated as Tract no. 1 and no. 2 of subdivision of the *A. J. Gaughran* estate according to a plat made by *H. D. Stockman*, surveyor, on October 29, 1939.

Tract no. 1 contains 9.71 acres and Tract no. 2 contains 36.69 acres, aggregating a total of 36.40 acres and for a description of the metes and bounds of said tracts of land reference is hereby made to the deed conveying said land to *J. J. McSavain* by *C. Innman*, Master, recorded in the Q. M. L. Office for said County and State in Vol. 1849 at Page 330.

The foregoing two parcels of land aggregating 36.40 acres, are the same tract this day conveyed to me by the said *J. J. McSavain*, and this mortgage is given to secure the entire purchase price of said parcels of land, and for that reason it is mutually understood and agreed that this constitutes in law and in fact a purchase money mortgage.
