until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid; then the whole amount due by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent besides all costs and expenses of collection to be added to the amount due on said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage; as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will more fully appear.)

All that piece, parcel, or lot of land in Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, situated about two and one half miles from the city of Greenville on the North side of the Spartanburg Road, adjoining lands of H. R. Jones on the South, Lot No. 2 of H. H. Amick Estate on the West, G. P. Mc Carter on the North, Lot No. 4 of H. H. Amick Estate on the East, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning on iron pin on G. P. Mc Carter line and corner of Lot No. 2 of H. H. Amick Estate; thence N. 86 1/2° E. 5.55 chains to iron pin on G. P.
