Dollars, to be paid as follows: Twenty-five (\$25.00) dollars on the first
day of October 1927 and the sum of \$25.00 on the first day of
each and every consecutive month thereafter for thirty-six consecutive
months, at which time the balance shall become immediately due and
payable with interest thereon, from Sept. 1st, 1927 on unpaid principal at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be
computed and paid annually.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents, do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said H. E. Rush,

all that certain piece, parcel or lot of land situate in Greenville Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, near the Corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and being a part of lot no. 14 and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:- Beginning at a point on Buist Ave. at point corner of lots 14 & 15 according to a plat thereof recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "E" page 106 and running thence with Buist Ave. in a westerly direction 5-9 feet to a stake; thence N. 30 E. through center of lot no. 14, 170 feet; thence in a parallel line with Buist Ave. in an easterly direction 5-0 feet to pin in line of lot no. 15; thence with line of lot 15 in a southerly direction 178 feet to the beginning corner.
