WHEREAS, *I, D. M. Richardson* and *Frances M. Richardson* SEND GREETING:

in and by *our* certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted unto THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA in the full and just principal sum of *Fifty-five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars (\$5500.00)*, with interest thereon from date heretofore, as at forth in said note, the ~~date~~ <sup>from date, at the dates and in the amounts as follows, namely:</sup>

principal of said note together with interest being due and payable in monthly instalments as follows:

Beginning on the first day of August, 1938, and on the first day of each month thereafter the sum of *Thirty-six and 30/100 (\$36.30) Dollars* and the balance of said principal sum due and payable on the first day of July, 1938. The aforesaid monthly payments of *Thirty-six and 30/100 (\$36.30) Dollars* each are to be applied first to interest at the rate of five (5%) per cent per annum on the principal sum of *Fifty-five Hundred and 00/100 Dollars*, or so much as shall from time to time remain unpaid, and the balance of each monthly instalment shall be applied on account of principal.

Said note provides that part of principal and/or interest shall bear interest at the rate of seven (7%) per cent. ~~as reference being had to said note will more fully appear default in any payment of either principal or interest to render the whole debt due at the option of the Mortgagor.~~ and with interest from date at the rate of ~~per cent per annum, payable annually on the~~

*All that certain piece, parcel of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the West side of Maple Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville Township, Greenville County, S. C. known and designated as Lot no. 17 in Block 6 as shown in plat of property of J. A. and P. T. Burton, recorded in the R. M. L. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in plat book 1, at page 103, and running, according to a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, *March 3, 1938*, the following metes and bounds, to wit:*

*Beginning at an iron pin on the West side of Maple Avenue, joint corner of Lots 16 and 17, iron pin also being 534.5 feet in a northerly direction from the Northwest corner of the intersection of Maple Avenue and Avondale Drive and running thence with the line of Lot no. 16 N. 81° 23' W. 169.1 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot no. 6; thence with the line of Lots 5 and 6 N. 5° 37' E. 75 feet to iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 17 and 18; thence with the line of Lot no. 18 S. 81° 15' E. 165.2 feet to iron pin on the West side of Maple Avenue; thence with the West side of Maple Avenue S. 2° 30' W. 75 feet to the point of beginning.*
