in and by our certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted unto THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA in the sum and just principal sum of Alice Sherrard and William Theodore Mattison (\$7,600.00) Dollars

with interest thereon from date hereof, at the rate set forth in said note the principal of said note together with interest being due and payable - in monthly instalments as follows:

Beginning on the first day of July 1939 and on the first day of each month thereafter the sum of forty-six and 20/100 (\$46.20) Dollars and the balance of said principal sum due and payable on the first day of June, 1959. Know that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the northwest side of Morningdale Drive near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 4 of Block I, on plat of Northgate, property of Utopian Developing Company made by L. M. Turner, Jr., Eng., and recorded in the R. M. B. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book 9, at pages 135 and 136, and having according to said plat, and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, May 18, 1939, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Morningdale Drive at the corner of Lot No. 3 said pin also being 427.8 feet in an easterly direction from the northeast corner of the intersection of East Avondale Drive and Morningdale Drive and running thence with the line of Lot No. 3, N. 9° 02' W. 175.7 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 5 S. 67° 27' E. 175.6 feet to an iron pin on the northwest side of Morningdale Drive; thence with said Morningdale Drive on a curved line S. 35° 29' W. 87 feet to an iron pin on said Drive; thence continuing with Morningdale Drive on a curved line S. 67° 53' W. 91.3 feet to the point of beginning.
