All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the north side of Crescent Avenue (formerly known as Alina Street) partly within and partly without the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 55 on plat of Alta Vista, recorded in the R. Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Crescent Avenue, joint corner of Lots No. 54 and 55, said iron pin also being 53.3 feet east from the northwest corner of the intersection of Crescent Avenue and Afton Avenue, and running thence with the north side of Crescent Avenue N. 85° 40' W. 53.3 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of Lots No. 55 and 56; thence with the line of Lot No. 56, N. 4° 15' E. 170.2 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 85° 40' E. 53.3 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots No. 54 and 56; thence with the line of Lot No. 54, S. 4° 15' W. 170.2 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Crescent Avenue, the point of beginning.

This is the identical property conveyed to the mortgagor herein by deed of J. H. Norwood, as Trustee, dated March 23, 1939, recorded in the R. M. B. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Deeds Volume 209, at page 508.
