WHEREAS,

SEND GREETING:

in and by my certain Note or obligation bearing even date herewith, stand indebted unto THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA in the full and just principal sum of Dollars (\$3,900.00) to be paid in 12 years from date, at the dates and in the amounts as follows, namely:

(a corporation duly chartered under the laws of the state of South Carolina and duly licensed to do business within the state of South Carolina by the laws of said state) in the full and just principal sum of Three Thousand Nine Hundred and no/oo Dollars (\$3,900.00) with interest thereon from the date hereof at the rate set forth in the note aforesaid said principal sum being payable in instalments of Nineteen and 50/100 (\$19.50) dollars each day, the first day of each and every month hereafter, the last instalment being the balance of principal remaining due, being payable on the 30th day of December, 1958, and said interest being payable monthly on the same day as the instalments of principal. Said note provides that past due principal and interest shall bear interest at the rate of seven per cent. per annum, as reference being had to said note, and more fully appear default in the payment of any instalment of principal or interest or render the whole debt due at the option of the mortgagee, and interest from date at the rate of 7 1/2 per cent. per annum, payable annually on the

1st day of November, and of each year, past due principal and interest to bear interest at the rate of 7 1/2 per cent. per annum, as reference being had to said note will more fully appear; default in any payment of either principal or interest to render the whole debt due at the option of the Mortgagee.

in hand well and truly paid by the said THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents DO GRANT, bargain, sell and release unto the said THE PRUDENTIAL INSURANCE COMPANY OF AMERICA the following described real estate, to-wit:

All that certain piece, ~~one-half acre~~ lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate, lying and being on the south side of East Fair Road near the City of Greenville, in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 18, of Block 3 on plat recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book 3 at pages 131 and 132 and having, according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. E. Dalton, March 23, 1940, the following lines and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of East Fair Road, joint corner of Lot No. 18 and 19, said pin also being 660 feet in a southerly direction from the southwest corner of the intersection of East Fair Road and Mitchell Street, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 19 S. 26° 25' E. 159.7 feet to a stake, thence with the rear line of Lot No. 4 S. 63° 35' W. 60 feet to an iron pin, thence with the line of Lot No. 17 N. 26° 25' W. 159.7 feet to a stake on the south side of East Fair Road, thence with the south side of East Fair Road N. 63° 35' E. 60 feet to the beginning corner.
