Beginning on the first day of October, 1940, and on the first day of each month thereafter the sum of Twenty-three and 76/100 (\$23.76) Dollars and the balance of said principal sum due and payable on the first day of September, 1968. All that certain piece, ~~piece~~ or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon situate, lying and being on the north side of East Earle Street in the city of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 16 of Section 7 on plat of Henry Ford Company property, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book A at pages 337-345, and having, according to said plat and a recent survey thereof made by R. E. Dalton, August 21, 1940, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of East Earle Street, said pin being 130 feet, 8 inches west from the Northwest corner of the intersection of East Earle and Bennett Streets, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 17, N. 18° 30' E. 143 feet, 10 inches to an iron pin on the south side of Garraux Street (also known as Second Avenue), thence along the south side of Garraux Street N. 66° 15' 24" 65 feet, 8 inches to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 15, S. 18° 30' 31" 150 feet to an iron pin on the north side of East Earle Street; thence with the north side of East Earle Street S. 71° 20' E. 65 feet, 4 inches to the point of beginning.
