M. L. Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book H, at page 284, and having, according to a recent survey made by A. E. Dalton, Engineer, March 11, 1938, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Bamile Avenue, joint corner of Lots 23 and 24, said pin being 246 feet East from the northeast corner of the intersection of McDaniel Avenue and Bamile Avenue, and running thence with the line of Lot no. 24 N. 13° 35' E. 143.3 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 78° 15' E. 60 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 22 and 23; thence with the line of Lot no. 22 S. 9° 12' W. 143.4 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Bamile Avenue; thence with the north side of said Avenue N. 79° 11' W. 54.7 feet to iron pin. thence continuing with the north side of said Avenue N. 73° 53' W. 16.3 feet to the beginning corner.
