Beginning at an iron pin on the south side of Stillcrest Drive, joint corner of Lots Nos. 125 and 126, said pin also being 140.2 feet East from the Southeast corner of the intersection of Bennett Street and Stillcrest Drive and running thence with the south side of Stillcrest Drive S. $66^{\circ} 55'$ E. 70.1 feet to iron pin joint corner of Lots Nos. 126 and 127; thence thence with the line of Lot No. 127 S. $17^{\circ} 41'$ W. 182.8 feet to iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 130 N. $71^{\circ} 0'$ W. 70.9 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot No. 125 N. $18^{\circ} 0' 3''$ E. 187.6 feet to iron pin on south side of Stillcrest Drive, the beginning corner.
