I do hereby grant, sell, assign, convey, transfer, and deliver unto the said The Prudential Insurance Company, all my right, title, and interest in and to a certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of Maple Avenue, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, known and designated as Lot No. 10 and Plat of John A. Burton, and having, according to survey made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, August 16, 1938, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the East side of Maple Avenue, which iron pin is 584 feet North from the Northeast corner of the intersection of Maple Avenue with East Avondale Avenue, and running thence with the line of lot No. 11, S. 86° 14' E. 109.9 feet to an iron pin, thence N. 2° 29' E. 75 feet to an iron pin, thence with line of lot No. 9, N. 86° 13' W. 114.6 feet to an iron pin on the East side of Maple Avenue, thence with the East side of Maple Avenue S. 0° 43' E. 75 feet to the beginning corner.
