money loaned this day, with interest thereon from this date at the rate of eight per cent. per annum payable weekly, the payment whereof the said party of the first part is anxious to secure:

Now, therefore, in consideration of the premises, and in further consideration of one dollar to him in hand paid, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, the said party of the first part has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the said party of the second part all that certain piece, parcel and lot of land lying in Greenville County, in the state aforesaid, as follows, to wit:

All that certain lot or parcel of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County and State aforesaid, near the city of Greenville, known and designated as Lot no. 68 in Block 3 of the subdivision known as Augusta Court, as shown on plat of record in the R. M. B. office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in the Plat Book F, page 124, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northern side of Augusta Court, joint corner of lots nos. 67 and 68, thence with the joint line of said lots N. 39-21 W. 164.2 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot no. 58; thence with the line of that lot N. 51-20 E. 59.83 feet to an iron pin on line of Lot no. 69; thence with line of that lot S. 39-22 E. 164.8 feet to an iron pin on Augusta Court; thence with Augusta Court S. 47-10 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning. Being the same lot conveyed to me by F. A. Talbott by deed dated Feb. 16, 1925 and recorded in the R. M. B. office for Greenville County in Vol. 98, page 69.
