SEND GREETING:

Whereas, the said Wilmet Realty Company

in and by its certain Promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, is well and truly indebted to Citizens Lumber Company

in the full and just sum of Seven Thousand and No/100 (\$7000.00) Dollars

, to be paid Sixty (60) days after date

, with interest thereon from date

at the rate of Six (6%) per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid quarterly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten (10%) per cent. of the amount due thereon, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

County, State aforesaid, on the Southern side of Tallulah Drive near the City of Greenville, being a portion of lots Nos. 11 and 13 as shown on plat of the property of J. T. Smith recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "F" at Page 100, and described as follows:

BEING at a stake on the Southern side of Tallulah Drive, 66-2/3 feet East from Smith Street, and running thence S. 25-40 E. 150 feet to a stake; thence N. 64-20 E. 66-2/3 feet to a stake; thence N. 25-40 W. 150 feet to a stake on Tallulah Drive; thence with the Southern side of Tallulah Drive, S. 64-20 W. 66-2/3 feet to the point of beginning.
