All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, state of South Carolina near Chick Springs and lying north of the Piedmont & Northern Railroad and being shown as lots Nos. 29, 30 and 31 on plat of property of G. D. Collier made by H. I. Donahoo, Engineer, October 20, 1947 and according to a recent survey by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:
