"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Greenville Township, on the east side of Carolina avenue, and being known and designated as Lots Nos. 16 and 17 of the subdivision of the F. M. Harris property known as Highlands as shown on plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, at page 146, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the east side of Carolina avenue at the joint corner of Lots Nos. 17 and 18, which point is 70 feet south of the southeast corner of the intersection of Carolina avenue and Hart street, and running thence along the joint line of Lots Nos. 17 and 18, N. 74-30 E. 130 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of said lots; thence along the rear line of Lots Nos. 22 and 21, S. 15-10 E. 140 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 15 and 16; thence along the joint line of said lots, S. 74-30 W. 130 feet to an iron pin at the joint corner of said lots on the east side of Carolina avenue; thence along the east side of Carolina avenue, N. 15-10 W. 140 feet to the beginning corner, including the plumbing, electrical and heating fixtures now located on said premises, or to be installed thereon, which are hereby expressly agreed to be a part of the realty.
