And said mortgagor agrees to keep the building and improvements now standing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged premises and any and all apparatus, fixtures and apparatus, insured against loss or damage by fire and such other hereafter in or attached to said buildings or improvements, insured against loss or damage by fire and such other hereafter in a wind any claim on the part of the insurers for co-insurance) satisfactory to the mortgages; that all insurance policies shall be held by and shall be for the benefit of and first payable in case of loss to the mortgages, and that at least fifteen days before the expiration of each such policy, a new and sufficient policy to take the place of the one so supring shall be delivered to the mortgage.
