WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto

, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of South Carolina, hereinafter called the Mortgagee, as evidenced by a certain promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the principal sum of Eight Thousand Seven Hundred Fifty Dollars (\$ 8,750.00), with interest from date at the rate of Five & one-fourth per centum (5 1/4 %) per annum until paid, said principal and interest being payable at the office of General Mortgage Co. in Greenville, South Carolina, or at such other place as the holder of the note may designate in writing, in monthly installments of Fifty-two and 50/100-----Dollars (\$ 52.50), commencing on the first day of August, 19 58, and on the first day of each month thereafter until the principal and interest are fully paid, except that the final payment of principal and interest, if not sooner paid, shall be due and payable on the first day of July, 19 83.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina:

ALL that lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the Southeast side of Monteith Circle and on the North side of Morris Court, near the City of Greenville, in Greenville County, South Carolina, being shown as parts of Lots 8 and 9 on Plat of Monteith Heights, made by Pickell & Pickell, Engineers, March 28, 1946, recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C., in Plat Book "B", page 185, and having according to said plat and a recent survey made by R. K. Campbell, June 21, 1958, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Southeast side of Monteith Circle at joint front corner of Lots 7 and 8, and running thence with the line of Lot 7, S. 60-0 E., 154 feet to an iron pin on the North side of Morris Court; thence with the curve of Morris Court (the chord being S. 81-48 W., 69.1 feet) to an iron pin; thence continuing with the curve of Morris Court (the chord being N. 73-06 W., 95.8 feet) to an iron pin; thence with the curve of Morris Court and Monteith Circle (the chord being N. 23-06 W., 16 feet) to an iron pin on the Southeast side of Monteith Circle; thence with the curve of Monteith Circle, (the chord being N. 36-54 E., 55 feet) to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and equipment now or hereafter attached to or used in connection with the real estate herein described.

To HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the
