State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying in Chick Springs Township, near the City of Greenville, on the southwestern side of Shannon Drive shown as Lot 71 on a plat of McSwain Gardens recorded in Plat Book GG, Page 75, more particularly shown on a plat of the property of Jack B. Thomas dated March 31, 1960, and according to said plat being more particularly described as follows:
