All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Parris Mountain Township, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, located on the Southern side of what is now known as East Perry Road, and being shown as all of lot number FIVE (5) on a plat of property entitled " LEAWOOD HILLS", made by Terry T. Dill, surveyor for Homer Styles and E. H. Baston, dated October 1958, and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the Southern side of the said road at the joint front corner of lots 4 and 5 and running thence N. 43-22 E., 100 feet along the Southern side of said road to an iron pin at the joint front corner of lots 5 and 6; thence S. 46-38 E., 113 feet as the common line of lots 5 and 6 to an iron pin on the line of the Sunset Hills Development; thence S. 43-30 W., 100 feet along the line of the said development to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of lots 4 and 5; thence N. 46-38 W., 112.8 feet as the common line of lots 4 and 5 to the beginning corner.
