And said mortgagor agrees to keep the building and improvements now standing or hereafter erected upon the mortgaged premises and any and all apparatus, fixtures and appurtenances now or hereafter in or attached to said buildings or improvements, premises and any and all apparatus, fixtures and appurtenances now or hereafter in or attached to said buildings or improvements, insured against loss or damage by fire and such other hazards as the mortgagee may from time to time require, all such insurence and in sums (not less than sufficient to avoid any claim on the part of the insurers for consumance) satisfactory to the mortgagee; that all insurance policies shall be held by and shall be for the benefit of and first insurance) satisfactory to the mortgagee, and that at least fifteen days before the expiration of each such policy, a new and payable in case of loss to the mortgagee, and that at least fifteen days before the expiration of each such policy, a new and sufficient policy to take the place of the one so expiring shall be delivered to the mortgagee. And in case proceedings for foreclosure shall be instituted, the mortgagor agrees to and does hereby assign the rents and profits arising or to arise from the mortgaged premises as additional security for this loan, and agrees that any Judge of jurisdiction may, at chambers or otherwise, appoint a receiver of the mortgaged premises, with full authority to take possession of the premises, and collect the rents and profits and apply the net proceeds (after paying costs of receivership) upon said debt, interests, costs and expenses, without liability to account for anything more than the rents and profits actually received.
