may also take possession of, and for filese purposes itse, any and all personal property sontained in the premises and used by Mortgagor in the rental for leading thereof or any part thereof. The right to entar and take possession of the premises and use any personal property therein, to manage, operate and conserve the saint, and/to collect the rents; issues and profits thereof, whether by a receiver or otherwise, shall be in addition to all other rights or renedies of Mortgagoe hereunder or afforded by law, and may be exercised concurrently therewith or independently thereof. After paying costs of collection and any other expenses indured the proceeds shall be sipplied to the payment of the indebtedness secured hereby in alloh order as Mortgagoe shall elect, and Mortgagoe shall not be liable to account to Mortgagoe for any action taken pursuant hereto other than to account for any rents actually received by Mortgagoe.

11. In case the indebtedness secured hereby or any part thereof is collected by shit or action or this mortgago is foreclosed, or put into the hands of an attorney's fees, which shall be immediately due and payable and added to the mortgago indebtedness accured hereby.

12. If the indebtedness secured hereby is now by hereafter truthed account.

- 12. If the indebtedness accoured hereby is now by hereafter further secured by chattel mortgages, pledges, equitacts of guarants, assignments of leases, or other securities. Mortgages may ut its option exhaust any lone or more of said securities and the security hereunder, either concurrently or independently, and in such order as it may determine.

 13. No delay by Mortgages in exercising any right or remedy hereunder, or otherwise attorded by law, shall operate as a waiver thereof or preclude the exercise thereof during the continuance of any default hereunder.
- 14. Without affecting the liability of Mortgagor or any other person (except any person expressly released in writing) for payment of any indebtedness secured hereby or for performance of any obligation contained herein, and without affecting the rights of Mortgagee with respect to any accurity not expressly released in writing, Mortgagee may, at any time and from time to time, either before or after the maturity of said note, and without notice or consent:

a. Release any person liable for psyment of all or any part of the indebtedness or for performance of any obligation.

Make any agreement extending the time or otherwise altering the terms of payment of all or any part of the indebtedness or modifying or waiving any obligation, or subordinating, modifying or otherwise dealing with the lien or charge hereof,

Exercise or refrain from exercising or waive any right Mortgagee may have.

d. Accept additional security of any kind.

- e. Release or otherwise deal with any property, real or personal, securing the indebtedness, including all or any part of the property mortgaged hereby.
- 15. Any agreement hereafter made by Mortgagor and Mortgagee pursuant to this mortgage shall be superior to the rights of the holder of any intervening lien or encumbrance.

If Mortgagor shall fully perform all obligations, covenants and agreements of this mortgage, and of the note secured hereby, then this mortgage and all assignments herein contained shall be null and void; otherwise to remain in full force and effect,

This mortgage shall inure to and bind the heirs, legatees, devisees, administrators, executors, successors and assigns of the parties hereto. Wherever used herein, the singular number shall include the plural, the plural the singular, and the use of any gender shall be applicable to all genders.
