"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the southern side of Wakefield Street (formerly known as Grove Street), and being known and designated as a part of Lot 10 of the Carson property, as shown on plat recorded in Plat Book E at Page 61, RMC Office for Greenville County, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at a stake on the southern side of Wakefield Street (formerly known as Grove Street), on the western corner of a 10 foot alley, and running thence along said alley, S. 1-15 W. 100 feet to stake; thence N. 88-45 W. 32 feet to stake; thence along line of property now or formerly of S.
