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(5) comply with all laws, ordinances, and regulations affecting said property;

(6) pay or reimburse the Government for expenses reasonably necessary or incidental to protection of the lien and priority hereof and to enforcement of or compliance with the provisions hereof and of any instrument secured hereby (whether before or after default), including but not limited to costs of evidence of title to and survey of said property, or recording this and other instruments, attorneys' fees, trustees' commissions, court costs, and expenses of advertising, selling and conveying said property;

AND THAT:

- (7) any amounts required herein to be paid by Borrower may, if not paid when due, be paid by the Government and there upon shall be secured hereby, bear interest at the rate borne by said note if only one is described, or, if more than one is described above and secured hereby, at the rate borne by the one selected by the Government in its sole discretion, and be immediately due and payable by Borrower to the Government, without demand, at the place designated in the note (8) neither said property nor any portion thereof or interest therein shall be assigned, sold transferred, or encumb voluntarily or otherwise, without the written consent of the Government;
- (9) at all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect said property to ascertain whether the requirements heréof áre being mef;
- t10) the Government may extend and defer the maturity of and renew and reamortize any debts secured hereby, religies, from liability any party liable thereon and release portions of said property from and subordinate the lien happort and waive any other rights hereunder, without affecting the fen or priority hereof or the liability of Boryower of any other party for payment of said debts;
- (11) default hereunder shall constitute default under any other real estate of crop or chattel security instrument held by the Government and executed or assumed by Borrower, and default under any such other security instrument shall
- (12) SHOULD BORROWER, or any one of the persons herein called Borrower, DEPAULT in payment of any debt, on performance of any covenant or agreement hereby secured or herein contained, or die or be declared in pleompetent. a bankrupt, or an in-ovent; or make an assignment for the benefit of creditors, the Government at its option may

- (13) at forcelosure or other sale of all or app part of said property, the Government and its agents may bid and purchase as a stranger and may pay the Government's share of the purchase price by crediting such amount on any debts of Borrower owing to or insured by the Government, in the order prescribed in pagagraph (14);
- (14) the proceeds of foreclosure sale, after being applied to the payent of costs and expenses incident to enforcing or complying with the provisions forcef, any prior liens required by law or a competent court to be so pill, and all indebtedness. secured Bereby, shall be applied in the following order to the payment of: (a) inferior lighs of record required by law of a competent court to be so paid. (b) at the Government's option, any other indebtedness of Borrower owing to of insured by the Government, and (c) any balance to Borrower;
- (15) as against the indebtedness hereby secured, with respect to said property, and to the extent permittell by law. Borrower hereby relinquishes, waives, and conveys all rights, inchoater consummate, of descent, dower, curtesy, homestead, valuation, appraisal, redemption, and exemption to which Borrower is or becomes entitled under the laws and constitution of the jurisdiction where said property lies;
