"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Northeast side of Willow Spring Drive at joint front corner of Lots 1 and 2 of Block D, and running thence with the line of Lot 1, N. 30-15 E. 145.5 feet to an iron pin on the Southwest edge of a 5-foot strip of land reserved for utilities; thence with said reserved strip of land, N. 48-27 W. 50 feet to an iron pin; thence with the line of Lot 3, S. 34-22 W. 154.4 feet to an iron pin on the Northeast side of Willow Spring Drive; thence with the Northeast side of Willow Spring Drive, S. 58-52 E. 60 feat to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to the mortgagor as J.
