ALL of that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon in Chick Springs Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, located in the new corporate limits of the City of Greer, lying on the eastern side of the Brushy Crock Road and on the western side of a small branch, being a part of Track No. 4, as shown on Plat of preperty of N.M.
