TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: We, Willie B. Cooper and Lavola Cooper

(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETING:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purpose, including advances made by the Mortgagee on other or no security:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns.

"All that certain piece, parcel of lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Paris Mountain Township, located at the presention of East Perry Road and Central Count and being shown as all of lot No. 12 on a plat of property entitled "Leawood Hills", made for E. H. Batson and Homer Styles by Terry T. Dill, surveyor, dated October 1958, and having the following metes and bounds, according to said plat to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwest side of Central Court at the joint front corner of Lots 12 and 13 and running thence N. 47=00 W. 114.3 feet as the common line of said lots to iron pin corner of East Perry.Road; thence S. 43-22 W. 78.0 feet along the southern side of said road to an iron pin; thence on a curve S. 02-46 E. the cord of which is 35.9 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 48-53 E. 88.7 feet still with Perry Road to an iron pin on Northwest side of Central Court; thence N. 43-30 E. 101.0 feet along the said Central Court to the beginning corner.

Together with all and singular the rights, members, hereditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging or in any way incident or appertaining, and all of the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures and any other equipment or fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.
