To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, Frances B. Revis, of Greenville County,

_...(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Chick Springs Township, on the south side of Galphin Drive, containing 2.5 acres, more or less, and having, according to a survey made by R. K. Campbell, March 21, 1953, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin in the center of Galphin Drive at the corner of other property now or formerly belonging to T. A. Wynn and Lois H. Wynn, which point is 484 feet southwest of the intersection of said Galphin Drive with a road formerly known as McCarter Shop Road, now Pine Knoll Drive; running thence with the center of said Galphin Drive, S. 80-30 W. 175 feet to an iron pin at the corner of a lot now or formerly belonging to Carl Ayers; thence along the line of that property, S. 4-00 E. 500 feet to an iron pin in the line of property formerly belonging to Kuykendall; thence with the line of that property, N. 54-02 E. 378 feet to an iron pin at the corner of other property of T. A. Wynn and Lois H. Wynn; thence on the new line across the property of Wynn, N. 30-28 W. 357 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to me by T. A. Wynn and Lois H.
