To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

We, L. C. Craig and Nancy J. Craig, of Greenville County,

... (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Seventeen Thousand and No/100------(\$ 17,000.00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot 117 of a subdivision known as Heritage Hill according to plat thereof dated May 26, 1964 by Piedmont Engineers & Architects and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book YY at Page 187 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

"BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Beaufort Street, joint front corner of Lots 117 and 118 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 17-40 W. 189.3 feet to an iron pin in the rear line of Lot 108; thence with the rear lines of Lots 108 and 109, N. 76-11 E. 100 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots 116 and 117; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 17-40 E. 178.8 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Beaufort Street, joint front corner of Lots 116 and 117; thence with the northern side of said Beaufort Street, S. 70-07 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed to us by Threatt Maxwell Enterprises, Inc. by deed dated May 13, 1965 to be recorded herewith."
