NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagee to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, Austin Township, being known and designated as Lot No. 27 of a subdivision known as Beechwood Hills as shown on plat thereof prepared by C. O. Riddle, November 1958 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at Page 35 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Beechwood Drive, joint front corner Lots Nos. 26 and 27 and running thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 80-45 E. 174.4 feet to an iron pin at the rear corner Lot No. 28; thence along the line of that lot, N. 3-38 W. 182.9 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Beechwood Drive (North); thence along the southern and eastern edge of Beechwood Drive, the following courses and distances: S. 83-06 W. 62.2 feet, S. 86-48 W. 74.1 feet, N. 89-25 W. 50 feet, S. 58-53 W. 57.4 feet, S. 14-04 E. 60 feet, S. 30-58 E. 55.1 feet, S. 26-07 E. 71.6 feet to the beginning corner; being the same conveyed to us by Wooten Corporation of Wilmington by deed dated August , 1959, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 632, at Page 274.
