To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

I, James A. Wood, of Greenville County,

_(hereinafter referred to as Mortgagor) SEND(S) GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor is well and truly indebted unto FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION OF GREENVILLE, SOUTH CAROLINA (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) in the full and just sum of

Sixteen Thousand, Six Hundred and No/100-----(\$ 16,600.00) Dollars, as evidenced by Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, said note to be repaid with interest at the rate

WHEREAS, said note further provides that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty days, or if there shall be any failure to comply with and abide by any By-Laws or the Charter of the Mortgagee, or any stipulations set out in this mortgage, the whole amount due thereunder shall, at the option of the holder thereof become immediately due and payable, and said holder shall have the right to institute any proceedings upon said note and any collaterals given to secure same, for the purpose of collecting said principal due, and interest, with costs and expenses for such proceedings; and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to the Mortgagor's account for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, repairs, or for any other purpose;

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said debt and to secure the payment thereof and any further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgage to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgage at and before the sealing of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following described real estate:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 16 according to a plat of property of J. T. Merritt and C. W. Wood prepared by Jones & Sutherland, January 28, 1960 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book UU, Page 80, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Eunice Drive, joint front corner of Lots 15 and 16, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 87-07 E. 201.7 feet to an iron pin; running thence N. 11-56 W. 108.7 feet to an iron pin in the line of Lot No. 17; thence with the joint line of Lots 16 and 17, N. 88-47 W. 174 feet to an iron pin on the eastern side of Eunice Drive, joint front corner of Lots 16 and 17; thence with the eastern side of said drive, S. 2-53 W. 100 feet to the point of beginning; being the same conveyed by C. W. Wood, Sr. by deeds dated August 30, 1960 and October 7, 1960 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Vol. 658, Page 30 and Deed Vol. 661, Page 293. The first deed named James W. Wood as grantee but the latter deed was a correction deed naming the grantee as James A. Wood.
