All that piece, parcel or tract of land in Oaklawn Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, on Fork Shoals Road and Pelzer Road, containing 36.4 acres, more or less, and having, according to a plat thereof prepared by Pickell and Pickell, Engineers, dated January 24, 1947, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for the County and State aforesaid in Plat Book "Q," page 157, the following courses and distances:
