NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt and for better securing the payment thereof to the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell, and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns, the following-described real estate situated in the County of Greenville , State of South Carolina:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, situate on the Eastern side of Pimlico Road, in the City of Greenville, being shown as LOT NO. 483, on a PLAT OF SECTION D, GOWER ESTATES, recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book RR at Page 192, and described as follows:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Eastern side of Pimlico Road, at corner of lot 484, and running thence with the Eastern side of Pimlico Road, N. 27-05 E. 59 feet and N. 23-35 E. 51 feet to iron pin, corner of lot 482; thence with the line of lot 482, S. 68-40 E. 160 feet to iron pin at the corner of lot 498; thence with the lines of lots 498 and 497, S. 26-12 W. 121 feet to an iron pin, corner of lot 484; thence with the line of lot 484, N. 64-43 W. 158 feet to the point of beginning.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that he is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that he has good right and lawful authority to sell, convey, or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances whatsoever. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
