NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, in Union Bleachery Village and being more particularly described as Lot 108 as shown on a plat entitled "Subdivision For Union Bleachery, Division of Cone Mills Corporation, Greenville, S. C." made by Piedmont Engineering Service, March 1959 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "QQ", at Pages 80 and 81. According to said plat, the within described lot is also known as No. 10, Stephenson Street (Avenue) and fronts thereon 66.4 feet.

The above is the same property conveyed to the mortgagors by deed dated July 15, 1959 and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 624, at Page 522.
