NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly patd by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the north side of Sumter Street near the City of Greenville being shown as a portion of Tract No. 34 on plat of Riverside Farms made by P. H. Foster, Surveyor, August, 1907 recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "K", at Pages 100-103 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of the intersection of Sumter Street and a 25 foot county road and running thence northwest from Sumter Street and running along said county road in a northwesterly direction 165 feet to an iron pin; thence turning at an angle of 90 degrees and running in a southerly direction 116.4 feet to an iron pin on the north side of Sumter Street; thence with the north side of Sumter Street in an easternly direction 201.9 feet to the beginning corner.
