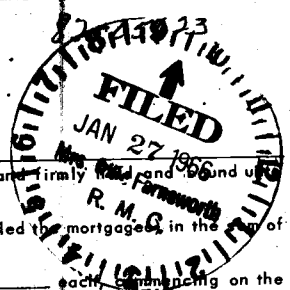


MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

**ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with the

being in the City of Greenville, on the Western side of
Palm Street and being more particularly described as follows:**

**BEGINNING at an iron pin at the corner of Lot 15 as shown
on plat of property of Sumlar Hall; and running thence
with the line of Lot 15, S. 86-24 W. 101 feet to an iron
pin; thence S. 3-49 W. 51.3 feet to an iron pin at the rear
corner of Lots heretofore conveyed to Miriam Chaney; thence
with the line of the Chaney lot in an Easterly direction
100 feet, more or less, to an iron pin on Palm Street,
which pin is 50 feet in a Northerly direction from the corner of
Palm and Nichols Street; thence with the Westerly side
of Palm Street, N. 1-53 W. 42.9 feet to the point of be-
