ALL that piece, parcel or lot of land with improvements thereon situate, lying and being in the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in the Town of West Greenville on the North side of Pendleton Street and South side of Branwood Street, known and designated as the Western portion of Lot No. 11 of subdivision known as Perry Avenue Annex and having, according to survey made by Pickell& Pickell, Engrs., October 29, 1945, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at a pin on the North side of Pendleton Street, 40 feet East from Woodside Avenue and running thence N. 13-15 E. 111 feet to pin on the South side of Branwood Street; thence along Branwood Street, S. 74-20 E. 16 feet to iron pin; thence S.13-15 W. 110.8 feet to pin on North side of Pendleton Street; thence along the North side of Pendleton Street, N. 72-20 West 16 feet to the beginning.
