with interest thereon from date at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be paid: in advance

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns:

"ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, lying and being on the north side of South Pliney Circle, in the Town of Simpsonville, being known and designated as lot No. 45 on the plat of League Estates as recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book K at pages 111 and 112, said lot fronting 100.1 feet on the north side of South Pliney Circle, having a depth of 215.4 feet on the westerly side, a depth of 210.9 feet on the easterly side and being 100 feet across the rear, and being the same property conveyed to Lawrence A. Cox and Nan H. Cox and in which the said Lawrence A. Cox did convey all his 1/2 interest to nan H. Cox by deed recorded in Deed Book 812 at page 219 in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office.

This instrument is given as a junior lien subject to first mortgage to Cameron-Brown Company with a present balance of approximately 10,500.00 and recorded in REM Volume 904 at page 365 in the Greenville County R. M. C. Office.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had thereform, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagoe forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.
