MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

To All Whom These Presents May Concern:

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, about two and one-half miles north of the City of Greenville, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 77 and 78, of Block C, of Mountain View Land Company as shown by plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, at Pages 396 and 397, and having, in the aggregate, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on Bailey Street, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 76 and 77, which point is approximately 150 feet from the intersection of Martin and Bailey Streets, and running thence with Bailey Street, N. 11-1/2 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 78 and 79; thence N. 89-1/2 W. 148 feet to an iron pin on a 10-foot alley; thence with said alley, S. 11-1/2 E. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint rear corner of Lots 77 and 76; thence S. 89-1/2 E. 148 feet to an iron pin on Bailey Street, the beginning corner.
