WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government will execute and deliver to the insured lender along with the note an insurance endorsement insuring the payment of the note fully as to principal and interest; and

WHEREAS, when payment of the note is insured by the Government, the Government by agreement with the insured lender set forth in the insurance endorsement may be entitled to a specified portion of the interest payments on the note, to be designated the "annual charge"; and

WHEREAS, a condition of the insurance of payment of the note will be that the holder will forego his rights and remedies against Borrower and any others in connection with said loan, as well as any benefit of this instrument, and will accept the benefits of such insurance in lieu thereof, and upon the Government's request will assign the note to the Government; and

WHEREAS, it is the purpose and intent of this instrument that, among other things, at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign the instrument without insurance of the note, this instrument shall secure payment of the note but when the note is held by an insured lender, this instrument shall not secure payment of the note or attach to the debt evidenced thereby, but as to the note and such debt shall constitute an indemnity mortgage to secure the Government against loss under its insurance endorsement by reason of any default by Borrower:

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of said loan and (a) at all times when the note is held by the Government, or in the event the Government should assign this instrument without insurance of the payment of the note, to secure prompt payment of the note and any renewals and extensions thereof and any agreements contained therein, (b) at all times when the note is held by an insured lender, to secure performance of Borrower's agreement herein to indemnify and save harmless the Government against loss under its insurance endorsement, by reason of any default by Borrower, and (c) in any event and at all times to secure the prompt payment of all advances and expeditures—made by the Government, with interest, as hereinafter described, and the performance of every covenant and agreement of Borrower—contained herein, or in any supplementary agreement, Borrower—does hereby grant, bargain, sell, release, and assign unto the Government, with general warranty, the following property situated in the State of South Carolina, County 1980 of Greenville.
