WHEREAS, first party is indebted to second party in the principal sum of

Twenty-Two Thousand Five Hundred - Dollars (\$22,500.00), as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, payable to the order of second party in successive annual installments of principal, the first installment of principal being

due and payable on the **First** day of **April** , 19 68, with interest from date of said note payable as and at the rate(s) provided in said note, principal and interest not paid when due to bear interest at the rate of six per centum (6%) per annum, all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as contained in said note will more fully appear by reference thereto, which note is made a part of this mortgage to the same extent as if it were set out in extenso herein. This mortgage also secures all advances made by second party hereunder, and under the terms of said note, all amounts included in all reamortizations, renewals, deferments, and extensions of any indebtedness hereby secured.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, that first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand paid by second party, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release, in fee simple, unto second party, its successors and assigns, the following described lands, including but not limited to, all trees, timber, shrubbery, fixtures and improvements now and hereafter thereon:

All that certain tract of land, containing 158.05 acres, more or less, known as the "Harper Farm", in Oaklawn Township, School District #110 of Greenville County, State of South Carolina, on Woodville Road about .6 miles from its intersection with U. S. Highway #25; Bounded now or formerly as follows: North by lands of Creamer; South by Woodville Road; East by lands of King; and West by lands of Martin; said tract of land being more particularly described according to plat prepared by H. G. Bailey, Surveyor, in 1920, of record in Plat Book T, pages 468 and 469, as follows:
