C., (hereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Nine Thousand and No/100ths -----

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns.

All that piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being at the Northwestern corner of the intersection of Gayle Street and Dumont Avenue near the City of Greenville, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 21 as shown on a plat of Rockvale, Section One, prepared by J. Mac Richardson, dated October, 1958, and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South Carolina, in Plat Book QQ at page 108 and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the Western side of Gayle Street at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 20 and 21 and running thence with the line of Lot No. 20 S. 88-02 W. 190 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 1-58 E. 80 feet to an iron pin on the Northern side of Dumont Avenue; thence with the Northern side of Dumont Avenue N. 88-02 E. 180 feet to an iron pin; thence with the curve of the intersection of Dumont Avenue and Gayle Street, the chord of which is N. 43-02 E. 14.1 feet to an iron pin on the Western side of Gayle Street; thence with the Western side of Gayle Street N. 1-58 W. 70 feet to the point of beginning.
