(6) To use the loan evidenced by the note solely for purposes authorized by the Government.

(7) To pay when due all taxes, liens, judgments, encumbrances and assessments lawfully attaching to or assessed against the property and promptly deliver to the Government without demand receipts evidencing such payments.

(8) To keep the property insued as required by and under insurance policies approved by, delivered to, and retained by the Government.

(13) At all reasonable times the Government and its agents may inspect the property to ascertain whether the covenasts and agreements

(14) The Government may extend and defer the maturity of and remem and reamortize the debt evidenced by the note or any indebteduels to the Government secured hereby, release from liability to the Government any party so liable thereon, release portions of the property from and subordinate the lien tereof, and waive any other rights beremder, without affecting the lien or priority tereof or the liability to the Government of Borrowei or any other party for payment of the note or indebtedness secured hereby except as specified by the Covernment in writing.
