with interest thereon from date at the rate of nine per centum per annum, to be paid at maturity.

WHEREAS, the Morigagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagoe for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagoe at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagoe, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagoe at and before the scaling and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, his granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagoe, its successors and assigns

TALL that curtain piece, purel or lot of land, with all improvements therein, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, hing and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, on the easterly side of White Horse Road at its intersection with Burdine Drive and having, according to a survey prepared by Jones Engineering Service, January 23, 1973, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4Y, Page 76, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the easterly side of White Horse Road at the joint front corner of the tract herein conveyed and property now or formerly of Washington Avenue Baptist Church and running thence N 62-23 E, 391 feet to an iron pin; thence S 18-27 E, 228.9 feet to an iron pin on the northerly side of Burdine Drive; thence with said drive S 68-17 W, 99.5 feet and S 60-59 W, 300 feet to an iron pin; thence with White Horse Road N 17-32 W, 124.3 feet and N 15-12 W, 103 feet to the point of beginning.



Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenances to the same belonging in any way incident or appoint of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner; it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee, its i ries, successors and assigns, forever

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfully seized of the premises bereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is lawfully authorized to sell, convey or encumber the same, and that the premises are free and clear of all liens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgagee forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

- (1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also secure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagor by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof. All sums so advanced shall be ar interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in writing.
- (2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgagee against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgagee, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premisms therefor when due; and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgagee the proceeds of any policy insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgagee, to the extent of the balance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not.
