

WHEREAS, the said Mortgagor(s) in and by their certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these Presents, well and truly indebted to BANK OF GREER, GREER, SOUTH CAROLINA.

hereinafter called Mortgagee, in the full and just sum of

to be raid in monthly installments of ONE HUNDRED SEVENTY-FIVE AND 81/100 (\$175.81) dollars, commencing on the fifteenth day of June, 1976, and on the fifteenth day of each successive month thereafter until principal and interest are paid in full, and if not paid sooner, the last such payment shall be due on the fifteenth day of May, 1984,

at the rate of nine (9%)per centum per annum, to be computed with interest thereon from date and naid

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina. County of Greenville, in Chick Springs Township, in the City of Green, situate on the eastern side of Depot Street and the west side of an alley and being shown and designated as Lots Nos. 14 and 15 as shown on plat prepared for Mrs. R. V. Davis, by W. A. Christopher in February, 1919, recorded in Plat Book E at page 238, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BDGINNING at a stake on the inside of sidewalk on the east side of Depot Street at the joint corner of Lots 15 and 16, and running thence with Lot 16, N. 72-20 E. 99.5 feet to an alley; thence with the west side of said alley, S. 12-00 E. 52 feet to a point at the joint corner of Lots 13 and 14; thence with the line of Lot 13, S. 72-20 W. 99.5 feet to a stake on the east side of Depot Street, N. 12-00 W. 52 feet to the point of beginning.

This property is subject to all restrictions, zoning ordinances, set-back lines, roadways, easements and rights-of-way of record, if any, affecting the above described property.
