NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of said delt and to secure the payment thereof and are further sums which may be advanced by the Mortgagor to the Mortgagor's account, and also in consideration of the sum of Three Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagor in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagor at and before the scaling of these presents, the receipt whereof is breedy acknowledged, has granted, hargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant hargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagor its successors and assigns, the following described real estate.

All that certain piece, parcel, or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or bereafter to be constructed thereon, situate, bring and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, being known and designated as Lot No. 49 of a subdivision known as River Downs, according to a plat thereof prepared by Piedmont Engineers, Architects and Planners, dated July 17, 1974, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book 4-R at Pages 75 and 76 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the northwestern side of Hackney Road, joint front corner of Lots Nos. 48 and 49 and running thence with the northwestern side of Hackney Road, S. 29-00 W. 115 feet to an iron pin at the intersection of Hackney Road and Suffolk Court; thence with the curvature of said intersection, the chord of which is S. 79-15 W. 31.97 feet to an iron pin on the southeasternside of Suffolk Court; thence with the southeastern side of Suffolk Court, N. 50-30 W. 73.17 feet and N. 53-23 W. 70 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 59; thence with the line of Lot No. 59, N. 24-35 E. 131.98 feet to an iron pin at the corner of Lot No. 48; thence with the joint line of Lots Nos. 48 and 49, S. 54-54 E. 177.08 feet to the beginning corner.
