ALL of that certain piece, parcel or tract of land situate, lying and being in School District 80 on the Fork Shoals Road in the County of Greenville and State of South Carolina, containing 240.6 acres, more or less, and being bounded as follows: On the North by lands now or formerly of Riddle and Scott and lands now or formerly of Harris; on the East by the right-of-way of Fork Shoals Road; on the South by lands now or formerly of S. B. Huff; and on the West by lands now or formerly of S. B. Huff. ALL that certain piece, parcel or tract of land containing 413.9 acres, more or less, situate, lying and being in School District 55 on the waters of the Saluda River, in the County of Laurens and State of South Carolina, and being bounded as follows: On the Northeast by lands now or formerly of the Estate of J. L. Anderson; on the Southeast by a roadway and lands now or formerly of J. K. Davenport, Jack Nance and the Estate of A. C. Stockman; on the Southwest by the 440 contour line of Lake Greenwood; and on the Northwest by lands now or formerly of Frank Whitaker, James Davenport, and the Estate of A. C. Stockman. The said tract being more particularly described according to a plat thereof made by Thos. C. Anderson, Engineer, dated January 17, 1952, and is duly recorded in the Office of the Clerk of Court for Laurens County, S.C., in Plat Book 8, at Page 103, which, by reference is incorporated herein as a part of this description.

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
