"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or hereafter constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, near Mauldin, S.C., known as Lot Number 190 in Pineforest, plat of which is recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County in Plat Book QQ at Pages 106 and 107 and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the eastern side of Vine Hill Road at the center of Lot 191 and running thence, S 70-48 E 150 feet to an iron pin; thence, N 19-12 E 121.2 feet to an iron pin on the Southern side of Ashwood Drive; thence with said Drive, N 61-53 W 127.3 feet to an iron pin; thence along the curved intersection of Ashwood Drive and Vine Hill, the chord of which is S 68-40 W 32.4 feet to an iron pin on the southern side of Vine Hill Road; thence, S 19-12 W 120 feet to the point of beginning.
