This property is conveyed subject to all easements, restrictions, zoning ordinances and rights of way of record, or on the ground, which may affect said lot.

This is the same property conveyed to the Grantor by deed of Frank P. McGowan, Jr., Master in Equity for Greenville County, recorded in Deed Book 1051, at Page 120, recorded February 16, 1977.

Grantees agree to pay 1977 county taxes.

This being the same property conveyed to Robert E. and Sandra F. Dacus by deed of Fidelity Federal Savings and Loan Association dated March 22, 1977 and recorded on March 22, 1977 in Deed Book 1053 at Page 152.

In case of breach of covenants numbered 2 or 3 above, the Mortgagee may pay taxes, levies or assessments, contract for insurance and pay the premiums, and cause to be made all necessary repairs to the buildings and other improvements, and pay for the same. Any amount or amounts so paid out shall become a part of the debt secured hereby, shall become immediately due and payable and shall bear interest at the highest legal rate from the date paid.
