these presents, am well and truly indebted to Southern Bank and Trust  
Company of Williamston, South Carolina

in the full and just sum of Six Thousand Four Hundred Nine and 58/100

(\$6,409.58) Dollars to be paid in Seventy-Two (72) equal installments in  
the sum of One Hundred Thirty-Nine and 34/100 (\$139.34) Dollars each,  
beginning December 8, 1983 and a like installment being due and payable  
on the 8th day of each and every calendar month thereafter until  
paid in full.

with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 16.00 per cent, <sup>a.p.r.</sup> ~~per annum~~ to be computed and paid monthly

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the  
same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and un-

the said Southern Bank and Trust Company of Williamston, South Carolina,  
its Successors and Assigns forever:

All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with improvements  
thereon, lying and situate in the Piedmont Manufacturing Company  
Village, in or near the Town of Piedmont, Greenville County, South  
Carolina, and being more particularly described as Lot No. 65 section  
4, as shown on a plat entitled (Property of Piedmont Manufacturing  
Company, Greenville County) made by Dalton & Neves, February, 1950,  
Sections 3 and 4 of said plat are recorded in Plat Book Y at Pages  
2-5, inclusive and Pages 6-9, inclusive, respectively. According
