## MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

thereinalter referred to as Mortgagor) is well and truly indebted unto JOSEPH L. MULLINAX, JR.

thereinafter referred to as Mortgagee) as evidenced by the Mortgagor's promissory note of even date herewith, the terms of which are incorporated herein by reference, in the sum of Forty-Five Thousand and No/100----

according to terms of promissory note executed of even date herewith,

with interest thereon from date at the rate of twelve per centum per annum, to be paid as provided in said note, and

WHEREAS, the Mortgagor may hereafter become indebted to the said Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced to or for the Mortgagor's account for taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs, or for any other purposes:

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN. That the Mortgagor, in consideration of the aforesaid debt, and in order to secure the payment thereof, and of any other and further sums for which the Mortgagor may be indebted to the Mortgagee at any time for advances made to or for his account by the Mortgagee, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three (Dollars (\$3.00) to the Mortgagee in hand well and truly paid by the Mortgagee at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release unto the Mortgagee, its successors and assigns:

ALL that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, together with all improvements thereon, situate, lying and being in the City of Greenville, County of Greenville. State of South Carolina, being known and designated as Lot No. 65 as shown on plat of property of "Cagle Park Company", prepared by R. E. Dalton, RLS, dated June, 1915, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Plat Book C, at Page 238, on July 20, 1915, and having, according to a recent survey by R. B. Bruce, RLS, dated August 31, 1961, the following metes and bounds:

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the northern side of Tindal Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 64 and 65, and running thence with the joint line of said lots, N. 1-09 W. 199.1 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 64 and 65, on the southern side of McKay Street; thence with the southern side of McKay Street, R. 89-15 E. 64.8 feet to an iron pin at the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 65 and 66; thence with the joint line of said lots, S. 0-14 W. 199 feet to an iron pin on the northern side of Tindal Avenue, at the joint front corner of Lots Nos. 65 and 66, which iron pin is located 334.8 feet west of the intersection of Tindal Avenue and Houston Street; thence with the northern side of Tindal Avenue, S. 89-07 W. 60 feet to the point of beginning.

This is the same property conveyed to the Mortgagors herein by deed of Joseph L. Mullinax, Jr., dated November 11, 1983, and recorded in the RMC Office for Greenville County, S. C. in Deed Book \_\_\_\_\_, at Page \_\_\_\_, on November 14, 1983.

Together with all and singular rights, members, herditaments, and appurtenences to the same belonging in any way incident or appertaining, and of all the rents, issues, and profits which may arise or be had therefrom, and including all heating, plumbing, and lighting fixtures now or hereafter attached, connected, or fitted thereto in any manner, it being the intention of the parties hereto that all such fixtures and equipment, other than the usual household furniture, be considered a part of the real estate.

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, all and singular the said premises unto the Mortgager, its heirs, successors and assigns, forever.

The Mortgagor covenants that it is lawfelly seized of the premises hereinabove described in fee simple absolute, that it has good right and is ry or encumber the same, and thet the premises are free and clear of all hens and encumbrances except as provided herein. The Mortgagor further covenants to warrant and forever defend all and singular the forever, from and against the Mortgagor and all persons whomsoever lawfully claiming the same or any part thereof.

The Mortgagor further covenants and agrees as follows:

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(1) That this mortgage shall secure the Mortgagee for such further sums as may be advanced hereafter, at the option of the Mortgagee, for the payment of taxes, insurance premiums, public assessments, repairs or other purposes pursuant to the covenants herein. This mortgage shall also occure the Mortgagee for any further loans, advances, readvances or credits that may be made hereafter to the Mortgagee by the Mortgagee so long as the total indebtedness thus secured does not exceed the original amount shown on the face hereof All sums so advanced shall bear interest at the same rate as the mortgage debt and shall be payable on demand of the Mortgagee unless otherwise provided in white.

(2) That it will keep the improvements now existing or hereafter erected on the mortgaged property insured as may be required from time to time by the Mortgager against loss by fire and any other hazards specified by Mortgager, in an amount not less than the mortgage debt, or in such amounts as may be required by the Mortgagee, and in companies acceptable to it, and that all such policies and renewals thereof shall be held by the Mortgagee, and have attached thereto loss payable clauses in favor of, and in form acceptable to the Mortgagee, and that it will pay all premiums therefor when due, and that it does hereby assign to the Mortgages the proveeds of any pubey insuring the mortgaged premises and does hereby authorize each insurance company concerned to make payment for a loss directly to the Mortgager, to the extent of the belance owing on the Mortgage debt, whether due or not

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
